New Elvis Song Discovered?

Wouldn't we all just love to hear a new song by Elvis that no-one had heard before and had lain undiscovered for many years? Well, a news story came out in the last week that this is indeed what had happened and that a new song had been discovered. The story...

Newschannel 3's I-Team say they have uncovered a recording that could change music history. Now, a new, never before heard recording, potentially a demo track, has surfaced that could be Elvis. The song is called 'Living to Love You.' According to Battle Creek attorney Violet Hinton, that recording has Elvis Presley singing. She says the song comes from songwriter Jimmie Crane and producer Albert Leigh, recorded in 1976, the year before Elvis died.

The recording had supposedly turned up in an attic of the wife of a songwriter, Albert Leigh, who had passed away, and was discovered by her sons. One of those sons lives in Battle Creek and brought the recording he believed to be Elvis to Hinton along with a table full of documents. "All the tapes, all the contracts, all the songs written by Jimmie Crane, copyrights," said Hinton.

Although forensic audio analysis has been carried out by an expert in the field which appear to point to the song being sung by Elvis Presley, Elvis fans in the world are very sceptical after hearing a few seconds of the recording, although if truth be told what little has been released thus far makes it rather difficult.

The Elvis fans worldwide who consider themselves experts themselves appear to be resigned to the fact that it is unfortunately a hoax but it certainly does begin to get us all thinking about the 'what if' scenarios, hoping and praying that yes, one day we would hear more Elvis songs which have so far remained hidden.

I do seem to recall that when Elvis died, a Music industry executive said that there were enough unreleased songs to keep publishing for a number of years, I wonder what happened to all those...


Graceland and Sony Music Entertainment did not respond to the speculation however, which would appear to indicate that there is no foundation to it, however you never know...

A large mural of Elvis Presley, called "Elvis, Elvis" which was painted by American Pop Surrealism artist Ron English and was inspired by Andy Warhol's "Double Elvis."

Elvis' 55 Cadillac Sold

The 1955 Cadillac Series 75 Fleetwood limousine that Elvis Presley used to transport his band to shows all over the Southern United States went up for auction at Bonham's Classic California sale on November 12th. It was sold for \$172,000, including the Buyer's Premium. Pre sale estimates were \$100-\$150,000.

From the catalogue: This well documented car was purchased by the King in January of 1956 and immediately repainted Black. He may have died a very rich man, but in '56 Elvis still needed his father to co-sign on the car. Unlike many older Cadillacs that head to auction with questionable Elvis ties, this Limo is a well
