Elvis to be a Grandad again

Lisa Marie Presley is going to have an extra special delivery - the singer is pregnant with twins. The daughter of Elvis and Priscilla is expecting with her fourth husband, Michael Lockwood. She is four and a half months pregnant with twins and at least one of the babies is a boy. "Michael said that he and Lisa have been trying to get pregnant for about a year," "He also said that they had a sonogram two weeks ago, and one baby opened its legs, and they saw something!' Michael was beaming." Lisa Marie – who has two teenage children with first husband Danny Keough – is "having a really hard time" with her pregnancy, "She has gained a lot of weight and feels terrible about herself. She can't stand to look in the mirror. It makes her miserable. She can be nice one minute but then horrible the next. It's difficult to be around her." Lisa Marie is suing the Daily Mail for libel over publishing an article alleging she is overweight. The 40-year-old daughter of Elvis Presley said the story, which was widely republished worldwide, forced her to confirm she is expecting a baby. Her UK lawyer Simon Smith said claims that she had an "unhealthy appetite" and is "growing like her dad" had left the star "deeply upset and offended". The singer is issuing the libel claim against the Daily Mail's publishers, Associated Newspapers, at the High Court in London.

FAB 5

Memphis Mafia member Jerry Schilling obtained four classic Beatle autographs on the memorable night of August 27, 1965 when the Fab Four visited Elvis. He is auctioning this unique rarity of the autographs of all four Beatles on a 5" x 8" piece of Elvis Presley stationery dated 8/27/65. Bidding estimates are \$50,000 and up. Fans of both the Beatles and Elvis now have a chance to bid on this extraordinary artefact in Heritage Auction Galleries' upcoming Music and Entertainment Signature Auction, to be held at the company's Dallas, Texas headquarters on April 5, 2008. "It was August 27, 1965. The Beatles were on the eve of playing Balboa Stadium in San Diego. Elvis was in the midst of shooting Paradise Hawaiian Style in Hollywood. That night, between 10 and 11 pm, John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Starr all arrived in limousines at Elvis' home in Bel Air, and Elvis personally greeted them at the door for what forever after became known as the "summit meeting" of Pop music and Rock and Roll.

"The autographs are sharp and clean in blue ink, the word 'Elvis' is pre-printed in the upper left corner, and the dynamic of the signatures of the 'Fab Four' on the stationery of 'The King' is - for lack of a better word - magical," said Doug Norwine, Director of Music and Entertainment Auctions for Heritage.

EL VIS 8/27/65

Todd Morgan, who for years has been Graceland's "public face," was found dead in his apartment. It had not been announced publicly yet, but Todd had just been promoted to a new position and was to report directly to Gary Hovey in Los Angeles, though he would remain in Memphis. He was due to go out to dinner last night (2nd March) with friends to celebrate his promotion, but did not show. Reports are he must have died in his sleep. Todd has been at Graceland since it was opened to the public in 1982. He started as a tour guide. Todd has worked on loads of creative projects for Graceland during recent years. He died at the age of 45. Our thoughts and Prayers go out to Todd's family and friends.
